Facility Update

Bridgeopolis Chess has completely vacated the Club space where we played over 100 events during the past 2+ years on Tropicana and Durango. We've been setting up the new space at 6284 Spring Mountain Road and also renamed ourselves to The Southern Nevada Chess Club (a dba of Bridgeopolis LLC). We are sharing the entire building with the Las Vegas Chinese School and appreciate them greatly for offering to sublease to us.

The new facility is significantly larger than our previous one. We can fit all 22 tables into the main playing area. There are individual rooms which we can access as well. One of them, "Room 7", is already setup as a Skittles room. Our small refrigerator is now in that room. The main room has an adjacent full kitchen with stove, microwaves, coffee makers, and full-sized refrigerator.

For the kids, we now have a fenced-in grass backyard.

Thursday Series

Our first tournament in the new facility will be the June Thursday Series. For this month, the Series will be held on June 13, 20, 25, and 27th. Note that three of these days are Thursdays and one is a Tuesday. This tournament appeals to players rated 900+, with some of our regulars being 1800+, with one round of G75+15 each night. GM Simul for everyone

We're having a SPECIAL event on Saturday June 15 @ 10:00am. Thanks to SNVCC member Peter Bodziony for the introduction, we have arranged with visiting Grand Master Zbigniew Pakleza (2560 USChess, 2489 FIDE) from Poland to have a simul for kids and adults. This Simul is an unrated game where the Guest (GM Pakleza) plays upto 25 players simultaneously. For this event, players will have clocks setup with 25+5 for them and 2 hours +5 seconds for the GM on a single game. We must have a minimum of 10 players to run the event and a maximum of 25 players. Kids and Adults may participate and it may be announced on social media like Facebook.

Scholastic: Immediately following the Simul, we will have our first Scholastic tournament at the new facility on Saturday June 15 @ 1:00pm. This kids-only tournament for players in grades 2-8 is great for experienced and inexperienced young players.

The cost for the Simul is \$35 for all. Kids who participate in the Simul and the Scholastic Tournament will receive \$10 off the entry fee for their Tournament. The registratiopn link for the Simul and Tournament can be found on our website.

Other tournaments being planned include a Blitz Tournament on Sunday June 23 and a Beginner tournament on June 29th. And, for Nevada Chess (the State

Affiliate), we are beginning to explore dates and ideas for the Southern Nevada State Championship.
